Parlane is a junior gold exploration company identifying exciting early stage exploration opportunities. Our management team has renowned technical expertise as well as significant financial and capital market experience.

## Big Bear

Located in the Nechako Plateau's prolific Omineca Mining District, the property consists of 31 claims covering approximately 14,366 hectares; access is via maintained FSR roads roughly 100km Southwest of Vanderhoof, British Columbia.

The Big Bear property is strategically located between New Gold Inc.'s Blackwater property, and their newly acquired Capoose property<sup>1</sup>. Big Bear is considered highly prospective for a geologically congruent occurrence to that observed at New Gold's Blackwater property; the deposit is characterized as a low sulphidation epithermal and/or subvolcanic porphyry to transitional mineralization system.

The Blackwater property maintains an indicated gold resource of 5.4 million ounces of gold and 25.5 million ounces of silver (165 million tonnes at an average grade of 1.01 g/t gold and 5.1 g/t Ag) with an additional 1.2 million ounces of inferred gold resource (39 million tonnes at an average grade of 0.94 g/t)<sup>1</sup>.

The Capoose property hosts an indicated gold resource of 0.4 and 26.6 million ounces of silver (31 million tonnes at an average grade of 0.38 g/t Au and 26.5 g/t Ag) and an inferred resource of 0.4 and 29.5 million ounces of gold and silver respectively (37 million tonnes at an average grade of 0.37 g/t Au and 24.6 g/t Ag)<sup>1</sup>.

## Mercedes

The property consists of three contiguous mineral claims totaling 360 hectares, and is located approximately 200 kilometres southeast of Hermosillo, in the state of Sonora, Mexico. Located within the Sierra Madre Occidental province, the Mercedes property is positioned within the historically productive Tertiary volcanic field which stretches from the U.S/Mexico border to central Mexico.

The Phase I surface exploration program, conducted in 2011, was aimed at evaluating the size and potential of the main mineralized zone, "La Lamosa" ridge, that has seen two drill programs by the previous operator. Drilling revealed strong gold mineralization, returning intervals including 144m averaging 0.49 g/t Au and 12.4 g/t Ag from surface and 57m averaging 1.15 g/t gold and 13.5 g/t silver from surface (NI 43-101 Technical Report Mercedes Property, February 28, 2011).
